VISUALS

The Education Foundation of Palm Beach County, in partnership with the generous support of the community and the Foundation's philanthropic and corporate partners, is building a 32,000 sq. ft. facility that will serve as an education innovation hub, helping ensure high-quality public education by providing equity and access to resources and innovative programming for students and teachers in Palm Beach County. The new building also includes a training facility, offering professional development for teachers and supporting over 100 programs, including the expansion of Red Apple Supplies, a free teacher resource store, equipping teachers with essential resources for their classrooms.





IMPACT



This project is the result of the tremendous growth of Red Apple Supplies, from distributing \$60,000 in FREE school supplies to 9 Title I schools in 2016, to \$1.4 million of supplies to 76 Title I schools in 2021-2022.

The Education Foundation's Red Apple Supplies Program anticipates serving nearly 90 public schools before the end of the 2022-2023 school year, thanks to the generous support of the community along with the Foundation's philanthropic and corporate partners.

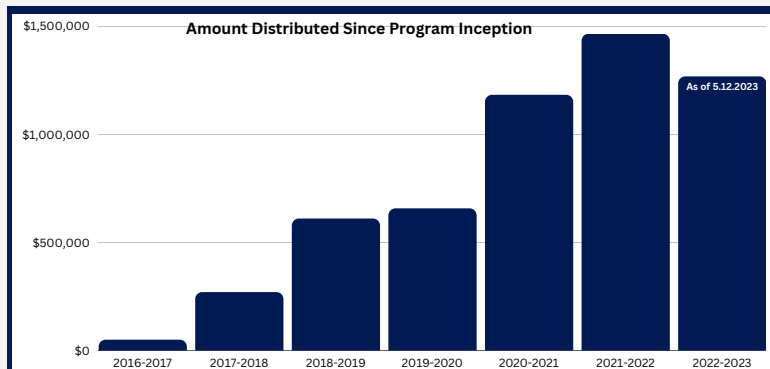

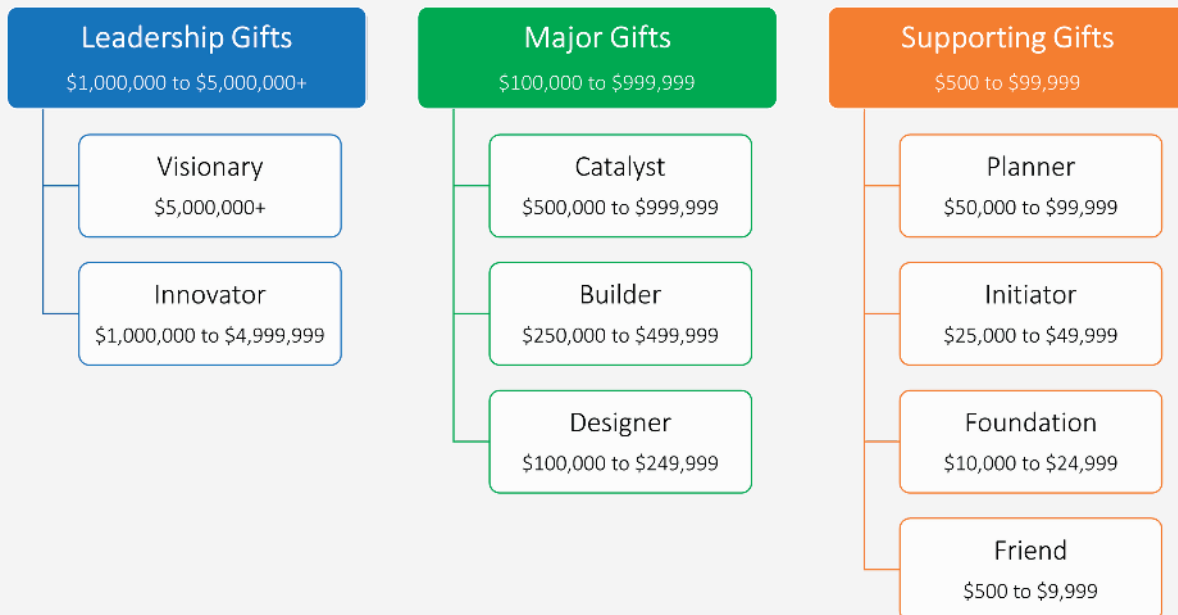

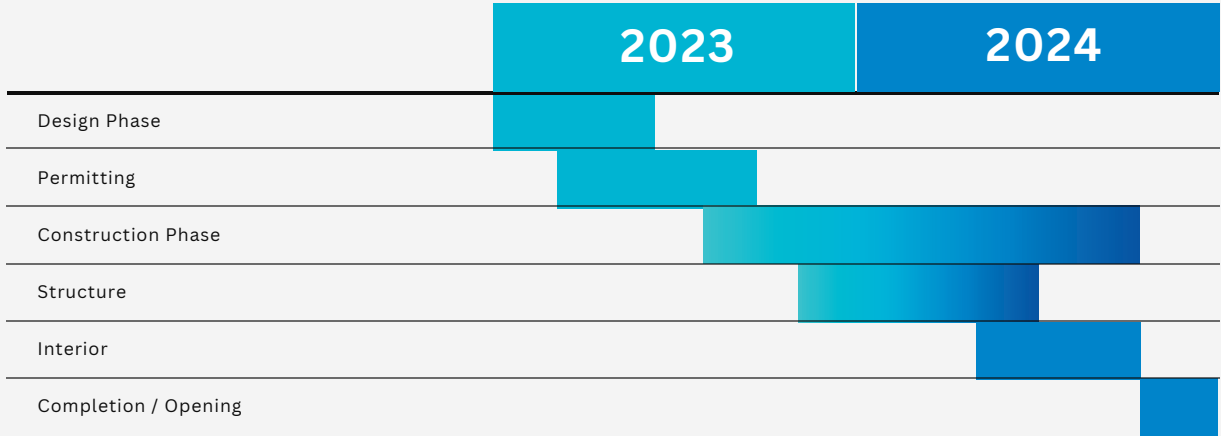
