The Education Foundation of Palm Beach County recently received two transformative gifts that will impact students and teachers for years to come. The Steven & Alexandra Cohen Foundation, led by Foundation President Alex Cohen, provided a \$500,000 grant to support the Education Foundation of Palm Beach County's *Brick by Brick, Mind by Mind* capital campaign, which helped fund the new 32,000 sq. ft. innovation hub in Lake Worth. In addition, the Education Foundation of Palm Beach County received a \$400,000 donation from George T. Elmore's Impact for Good Initiative, through the Community Foundation for Palm Beach and Martin Counties, which will go towards an endowment for future programs and operational expenses.

We award grants, support innovative programs and scholarships, and provide necessary school supplies and resources through *Red Apple Supplies*, our signature program. With more than 100 initiatives, the Foundation helps close achievement gaps, prepare students for post-secondary success and create measurable, positive change for over 100,000 students.
